The 650 Horizon balances the ability to handle offshore conditions with an impressive range of luxury appointments, demonstrating a level of versatility that undoubtedly contributed heavily to its success in the AMIF awards.

It offers the ultimate family boating experience with a long list of creature comforts including carpeted floors, beautifully designed upholstery, adjustable driver's bucket seat, removable dining table and day bed.

Of course aesthetics alone were not enough secure the judge's vote.

Practicality is also featured heavily with clever design maximising storage space. On board you'll find twin 90 litre storage areas, a rear 60 litre cold storage or bait tank and 220 litre storage under the rear lounge.

The boat also features a toilet, wash basin, vanity, sink, stove, fold down bench and a 65 litre fresh water tank.

Safety, stability and bluewater performance are practically guaranteed thanks to the 21 degree performance deadrise hull, and is backed up again by the Haines Hunter seven year structural warranty.

The 490 ProStrike was also recognised in the Boat of The Year awards, taking out the Trailerable Fishing category.
